### Program aims

The program aims to produce graduates who have developed:

- a high degree of knowledge about the theoretical, legal and ethical aspects of professional editing and publishing
- practical knowledge and skills in key areas of professional editing and publishing.

### Program objectives

On successful completion of the Graduate Certificate in Editing and Publishing, students will demonstrate a fundamental knowledge of:

- design concepts
- technical skills
- legal and ethical constraints
- editorial processes in the publishing environment.

This program focuses on editing and publishing in the print or text medium and includes activities associated with online publication.

### Admission requirements

To be eligible for admission to the Graduate Certificate in Editing and Publishing, applicants are required to complete a three-year Bachelor degree in any recognised tertiary field, or equivalent at pass level or above.

Note: There will be no admission for the Graduate Certificate in Editing and Publishing for commencement in Semester 2.
